GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Performs routine (journey-level) work meeting the needs of individuals with developmental disabilities. Work involves assessing and determining individual resident needs, and developing and implementing appropriate programs. Works under moderate supervision, with limited latitude for the use of initiative and independent judgment.

EXAMPLES OF WORK PERFORMED

Participates in developing resident programs.

Reviews resident program plans for effectiveness.

Observes and interacts with residents and documents observations and interactions to assess residents' responses to programs and services provided.

Monitors resident behaviors and recommends positive behavioral support plans.

Records information on the needs and strengths of residents.

Performs related work as assigned.

GENERAL QUALIFICATION GUIDELINES

EXPERIENCE AND EDUCATION

Must meet specific requirements of Title 42, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 483.430.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

Knowledge of rehabilitation programs for individuals with developmental disabilities.

Skill in the use of a computer and applicable software.
