

Based on information self-reported by the agency, the following items are worth noting.

## Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Employees

The agency's full-time equivalent (FTE) employee limitation decreased by 2.1 percent to 39,467.4 FTEs in fiscal year 2016 compared to fiscal year 2015. Compared to fiscal year 2012, the agency saw an increase of 379.6 (1.0 percent) in the total number of FTEs. In fiscal years 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, and 2016, the agency employed 6.5, 14.0, 10.3, 13.5, and 11.1 federally funded FTEs, respectively. Those FTEs do not count against the FTE limitation.
